DRACULA

Vlad III was born in 1431 in what is now Transylvania, the central region of modern-day Romania. However, the link between Vlad the Impaler and Transylvania is tenuous. Dracula is linked to Transylvania, but the real, historic Dracula — Vlad III — never owned anything in Transylvania. Bran Castle, a modern-day tourist attraction in Transylvania that is often referred to as Dracula's castle, was never the residence of the Wallachian prince. Because the castle is in the mountains in this foggy area and it looks spooky, it's what one would expect of Dracula's castle. But he never lived there. He never even stepped foot there.

When Vlad II was called to a diplomatic meeting in 1442 with Ottoman Sultan Murad II, he brought his young sons Vlad III and Radu along. But the meeting was actually a trap:
All three were arrested and held hostage. The elder Vlad was released under the condition that he leave his sons behind.

In 1431, King Sigismund of Hungary, who would later become the Holy Roman Emperor, inducted the elder Vlad into a knightly order, the Order of the Dragon. This designation earned Vlad II a new surname: Dracul. The name came from the old Romanian word for dragon, "drac." His son, Vlad III, would later be known as the "son of Dracul" or, in old Romanian, Drăculea, hence Dracula. In modern Romanian, the word "drac" refers to another feared creature — the devil.

The Order of the Dragon was devoted to a singular task: the defeat of the Turkish, or Ottoman Empire. Situated between Christian Europe and the Muslim lands of the Ottoman Empire, Vlad II's (and later Vlad III's) home principality of Wallachia was frequently the scene of bloody battles as Ottoman forces pushed westward into Europe, and Christian forces repulsed the invaders.

Anyway, the most interesting thing about Dracula is that there are no true facts about his actual death, so it's still a mystery. Some people say that he is still wandering around as a vampire, some are convinced that he was killed and taken away.



EGLE, QUEEN OF SERPENTS

One warm summer day, Eale, the youngest daughter of a local farmer, went bathing in the sea with her two sisters. Afterwards, returning to the shore to get dressed, she found a serpent in her clothes. Another popular legend is that there was once a forest in the area, but due to battles it was burned down. Then, the area became a wasteland. The temperatures were very low and when the army passed through the wasteland, all of the soldiers turned into rocks.

According to the local villagers, new figures appear every 5-6 years. There are four places at the Balkans where you can see this phenomenon, three of which are in North Macedonia.





PINOCCHIO

Pinocchio is a puppet; Pinocchio's maker is Geppetto; and Pinocchio's nose grows when he lies. Pinocchio is known for having a short nose that becomes longer when he is under stress, especially while lying. In the original tale, Collodi describes him as a "rascal," "imp," "scapegrace," "disgrace," "ragamuffin," and "confirmed roque," with even his father, carpenter Geppetto, referring to him as a "wretched boy," Upon being born, Pinocchio immediately laughs derisively in his creator's face, whereupon he steals the old man's wig.

Pinocchio's bad behavior, rather than being charming or endearing, is meant to serve as a warning. Collodi originally intended the story, which was first published in 1881, to be a tragedy. It concluded with the puppet's execution. Pinocchio's enemies, the Fox and the Cat, bind his arms, pass a noose around his throat, and hang him from the branch of an oak tree.

A tempestuous northerly wind began to blow and roar angrily, and it beat the poor puppet from side to side, making him swing violently, like the clatter of a bell ringing for a wedding. And the swinging gave him atrocious spasms...His breath failed him and he could say no more. He shut his eyes, opened his mouth, stretched his legs, gave a long shudder, and hung stiff and insensible.



THE LEGEND OF SHAHMERAN



from him. in the end Tugay woke up and burst into tears over the story he had with Trump which was only, unfortunately, a dream.



In this activity participants need to follow a map that has 5 different activities where they need to use their creativity and adaptivity. They were split in 5 small teams, simulating a Hobbit summer camp!







SLACK MEETING

A slackline is put up between 2 trees. 2 members of the team have to meet at the middle of the slackline without fall or touching the ground, while the others can support (the support group is allowed to touch the ground).

THE RIDDLE

Each group obtain a different riddle. It involves a little treasure hunt in order to search for the hints and creative thinking for finding the answer.

TOTEM DANCE

Participants are asked to dance around a totem for 3 laps. Each participant had a different handicap (dance with 1 leg, with eyes closed, backwards or 4 handed like a cat)






CIRCLE OF FIRE

All the participants are asked to enter a circle drawn on the ground and they cannot step outside of it. They need to work in team in order to gather 5 objects near the circle, but clearly not reachable with just stretching the arm. They work in creative way in order to create little paths towards the objects.



After each activity, participants receive a grade from the workshop facilitators, and in the end all the groups have joined a little ceremony!





% BLIND ONE-LINERS ♦%

Each person received a piece of paper and a pen. They were divided into pairs and asked to draw each other without looking at the paper and without lifting the pen. Only one person could draw at the time. Then they changed the roles. Activity could be repeated but the person has to be changed.

* PERFECT ERASMUS * FROJECT

At the begging everyone had to write idea of one project they would like to take part in. Then they were divided into groups by their ideas.In groups, they were asked to prepare poster with information about project, countries that will participate, activities and place of the project. At the end of the activity they were asked to present the results.





% counting focus ♦%

The whole group sits down and gets comfortable, closes their eyes and breathes deeply. The goal of the game is to count until everyone in the group has said only one number. If someone says the same number at the same time, they start from "one" again.

% MAKE A STORY ⋄}

This activity is good for pushing creativity. On one A4 format paper everyone in the group needed to write one sentence and make up a story.

Participants are asked to connect to the picture, to isolate the feeling, emotion or concept that had made them choose.

FRATIONALIZATION

A little explanation about allegory (the visual rationalization of an idea. Could be a character or a place). Participants are asked to draw or explain in a creative way their allegories and share them with other participants in small groups.




REFLECTION

Reflection circle about allegories in human history. The conversation can easily switch from ancient Greek gods to Asian figurative alphabets.








% CHARADES ♦ %



- To implement this in other EU projects






§ * ANDREJ ALEKSANDROV * }
